Ban On Water Softener Salt Use

The Hamburg Township Board of Trustees. Adopted an Ordinance (taking effect in May) that prohibits the use of salt in water softeners for residents who are hooked to the municipal sewer system. Residents are required to switch to potassium chloride – a more expensive product. Those who violate this Ordinance will be fined \$75.00 per quarter. This action was taken in an effort to reduce the sodium chloride levels at the sewer plant which are currently more than double the State's limits.
